Responsibilities for the Manufacturing Engineer include but are not limited to:

1. Help promote a proactive and positive safety culture within Certarus and its suppliers
2. Commission new equipment to verify quality control and that each unit meets all functional requirements
3. Assist product engineers to procure critical parts and manage key supply chain efforts
4. Confirm supply chain deliveries are on schedule, allowing all production schedules to be met. Provide weekly update at shop meetings
5. Provide a presence in the manufacturing facility as Certarus’ liaison
6. Verify QA/QC documentation for the shop
7. Lead efforts to repair equipment in the shop
8. As the successful candidate grows into the role, periodic field travel will be the expectation to assist in training other new personnel on the workings of the manufactured equipment to gain consistency of knowledge throughout the organization
